Collapsible hardwood wheelhouse with insulated 5 piece roof. Double doors from wheelhouse open onto rear deck with stainless steel stanchions. Wheelhouse doors port and starboard to facilitate manoevres.

Fixed fold out wheelhouse table and convertible bench seating (converts to double bed). Curtains for wheelhouse when used as sleeping cabin.
